

Time Management Activities for Students

In this document, you will find one time management worksheet for each lesson. Print one worksheet for each student when working on lessons 1, 2 and 3. Also, print one worksheet per group for lessons 4, 5 and the Eco Picture Diary Construction.

By pre-planning, students will be aware of their time management throughout each lesson. You will be guiding them in completing the "Work Time" column by discussing their tasks and the actual due date (time allotted) for that lesson.
